


GIVE+ Kiosk



Give+ Kiosk puts the power of kiosk giving into a portable unit that can be easily moved to different locations to collect tithes and offerings at services, gifts to various church funds or payments for special events, school programs and other activities. Your church can add custom logos and messages to create an instant connection with members and guests when they use your kiosk.

Empower self-service giving

Give+ Kiosk empowers self-service giving anywhere in your church community. It's quick and easy to use — just swipe a debit/credit card, choose a fund and enter the amount to give. The kiosk can print or email a receipt for tax purposes and a donation slip for the collection basket.

Streamline reporting

Give+ Kiosk simplifies church reporting and recordkeeping since donations appear on standard Vanco reports. If you already import Vanco transactions into your ChMS, you'll also be able to import kiosk donations.

Start accepting donations out of the box

Your kiosk comes with everything you need to start accepting donations right out of the box. It includes an iPad Air with secure enclosure, an encrypted card reader for secure debit/credit processing, a roll of paper to print recipients, plus Vanco's outstanding service and support. The iPad is already configured with your church's branding, so there's no complicated set-up required. When your kiosk arrives, plug it in, connect to your Wi-Fi and you're ready to get started.

Easy to move and secure

Give+ Kiosk is easy to pick up and move where it's needed, or to safely store when not in use. It measures 13.5 inches tall, 16.1 inches wide and only 9.9 inches deep. If your church wants the kiosk in a fixed location, you can take a few simple steps to secure it. The iPad is protected in a locked enclosure, so there is no concern that it can be removed from the kiosk. It can also be password protected to ensure that its use is limited to the Give+ Kiosk app.

4X the demand

Our recent survey of more than 1,000 U.S. churchgoers found that only 6 percent said their churches offered kiosk giving, but nearly a quarter of those surveyed said they would prefer to donate through a kiosk.





How it works


1. Get started

Your church logo and custom colors will appear on every screen. You can add a custom message to your welcome screen.




2. Choose donation

You select the donation categories to be displayed. Donors can choose from a pre-selected amount or enter their own amount.



3. Swipe card

Donors can enter their address or simply swipe their card to complete their donation. They can then choose to have a receipt emailed to them. You have the ability to add a custom message to this screen.



4. Print receipt

Donors can print a receipt for their records and/or a donation slip for the offering plate. You can add a custom thank you message to this screen.
